It is good to have rules to stick to especially those we have made in our groups like being kind to our friends and saying kind words not hurtful ones.

When people are hurt at HETTY by something that has been said or done to them, our teachers make sure we understand what has happened and how we can make it better.

We play lots of games at HETTY where we have to take turns or share. We are learning how to do this and sometimes we have to compromise like giving one of our cars to a friend while we wait our turn for the bigger car, or letting our friend bath the dolly first while we get the pram ready.

Rule of law

We have rules at HETTY to keep us all safe and happy.

When the tambourine sounds at HETTY, we know that means it's tidy up time. This rule is for everyone - both the children and the grown ups too.

Sometimes it's hard as a little person to work out right from wrong, but here at HETTY we are shown right and wrong by our teachers. They might tell us a story to demonstrate it, play a game, use the puppets, sing a song or watch something on the IWB. We are only little, but we are always learning.

Little people have big emotions and sometimes it's hard for us to understand why we throw tantrums or act in a certain way. At HETTY we are taught that the way we act can also affect our friends and so our teachers help us to understand this by explaining things to us.
