<i>What to do if...</i>	<i>Action needed</i>	<i>Return to school when...</i>
<p>...my child has a runny nose, similar minor ailment or a sore throat (with none of the three symptoms listed below – temperature, loss of taste/smell and continuous cough).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Send them into school <p>We will monitor all children and contact parents/carers where we think they need to be taken home. We will be taking a cautious approach to ensuring that children are collected where we feel they may be unwell.</p>	<p>...they feel better providing they do not develop any further symptoms.</p>
<p>...my child has coronavirus symptoms <i>Main symptoms are currently listed as:</i></p> <p><i>a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)</i></p> <p><i>a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)</i></p> <p><i>a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate – as a household. Brothers or sisters should not attend school whilst awaiting test results. • Get a test • Inform school <u>immediately</u> about test result. (see below) 	<p>...the test comes back negative.</p>
<p>...my child tests positive for coronavirus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Self-isolate for 14 days <p>Please alert the school. Inform school <u>immediately</u> about test result.</p> <p><u>Informing School of positive test during the school day</u> To inform school that your child has tested positive, please telephone school on 01244 323890.</p> <p><u>Out of hours</u> To let us know about a positive test result out of school hours, please telephone or text 07510 002669.</p> <p>OR email medical@hooleprimary.cheshire.sch.uk The out of hours line will be manned from 7am – 9pm every week day and 9am – 5pm at weekends.</p>	<p>...they feel better. They can return to school after 14 days even if they have a cough or loss of smell/taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone.</p>

	<p>PLEASE MAKE CONTACT AS SOON AS A POSITIVE RESULT IS CONFIRMED. This will enable us to contact relevant children/groups who will need to self-isolate before they make the journey to school.</p>	
...somebody in my household has coronavirus symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate • Household member to get a test • Inform school immediately about test result 	...the household member test is negative.
...I am contacted by school to inform me that someone in my child's group has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • School will confirm that date that your child may return to school • Brothers and sisters who are in other classes may continue to attend school unless the child who has been told to self-isolate (because of a confirmed case in their group bubble) develops symptoms. 	...
...my child, who is self isolating as someone in their group has tested positive, starts to display symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate – as a household. Brothers or sisters should not attend school whilst awaiting test results. • Get a test • Inform school <u>immediately</u> about test result. 	
...somebody in my household has tested positive for coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate for 14 days • Inform school 	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
... NHS test and trace have identified my child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms or confirmed coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate for 14 days 	...the child has completed 14 days of self-isolation
...we/my child travelled and has to self-isolate as part of a period of quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Term time holidays, including absence as a result of needing to quarantine, are unauthorised. 	...the quarantine period of 14 days has been completed

	<p><u>Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school • Self-isolate for 14 days 	
<p>...we have received medical advice that my child must resume shielding.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not come to school • Contact school as required by the pastoral team • Shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	<p>...school inform you that restrictions have been lifted and your child can return to school again.</p>
