We usually operate an open door policy at HETTY but obviously because of the current Covid-19 situation, we won't be able to do this as easily. We would really appreciate you either emailing the HETTY office on hettymanager@hooleceprimary.cheshire.sch.uk or calling us on 01244 500908 if you have concerns, queries or information. Thank you for your understanding.

Here at HETTY we are doing everything possible to keep your children safe including washing hands, cleaning and sanitising equipment throughout the day. However, if we do have a reported case of Covid-19 within the setting, it might be necessary to have to close HETTY for 2 weeks as advised by Public Health as we are following government guidelines. If this was the case, we would notify you as parents via the HETTY website or email. Please do therefore ensure we have your up to date contact details and keep checking the website on the home page Covid-19 link and also the news page.

We are aware that some of our children are asthmatic and therefore need inhalers from time to time. If your child does need one, or any other medication, please can you make sure that you send a named inhaler or other medication into HETTY that we can keep in a secure place should it be needed? You will also need to complete a form for our records.

Please be aware that if you go on holiday to one of the current holiday destinations that has been highlighted by the government as a place that will need a quarantine on return, you must keep your child off HETTY for 2 weeks after your return home.



Please could we have any Nursery Education Grant (NEG) forms back ASAP. If we do not receive them, then unfortunately you will be charged for your child's hours.

As the weather will probably be turning a bit cooler soon, please could you make sure that you send a **named** coat in with your child each day. Outside play is a big part of the day at HETTY and so coats will be needed. Also, any other items of clothes (hats, gloves, spare clothes, etc) and bags **must be named** as we have a huge number of children which means things might get mixed up. It would be useful if you could also send a spare change of clothes in with your child each day in case they need to change.
