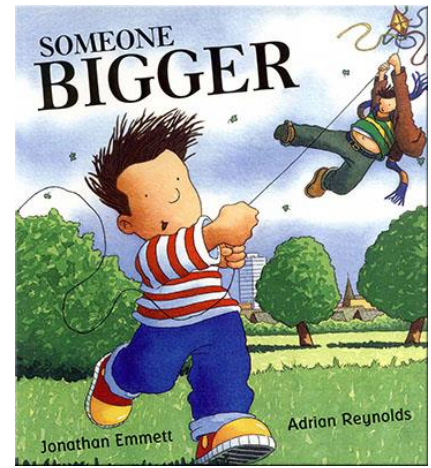


Someone Bigger

- Line up all the members of your family and put them in height order
- Line up all your dolls/teddies and put them in size/height order
- Download a spot the difference activity sheet for the story here <https://www.scribblestreet.co.uk/games/difference/someone/SomeoneDiff.pdf>
- Draw a map of where the kite flew over and include pictures of the people and animals
- Look on google maps aerial view of where you live and imagine how it would feel to fly over your house. Can you see any landmarks you recognise?
- Design your own kite using this template <https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/kite-colouring-page-t-tp-69747>
- Make your own paper kite following these instructions <https://www.instructables.com/id/Easy-Paper-Kite-for-Kids/>
- Cut out 10 kite shapes and attach string/ribbon to them. Number them 1-10. Clip pegs or paper clips onto the string/ribbons according to the number on the kite, or tie the corresponding number of bows onto each ribbon/string
- Print out and colour in these kite pages <https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/kites-colouring-pages-t-tp-69745>
- Make a kite chain using drinking straws, tissue paper and string. Glue the straws into a kite shape onto tissue paper and cut the kite out when dry. Decorate and add a tail, then thread string through the horizontal straw and keep going until your chain is complete (see picture)
- Make a stained glass kite
- Make a kite out of pasta shapes (spaghetti and bows)
