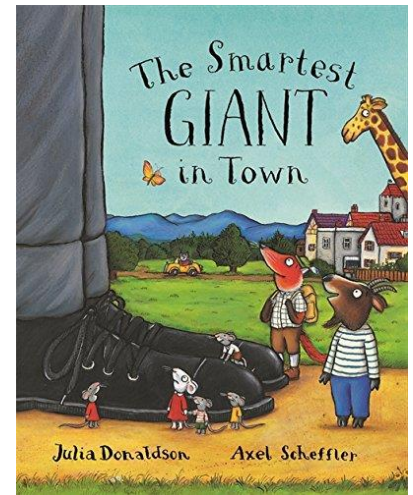


The Smartest Giant in Town

- Draw tie shapes on paper and decorate with different patterns
- Have a selection of socks of different shapes and sizes and get the children to pair/match them up
- Open a clothes shop in the living room and write price tags for each item – expand on this by creating sums by adding two or three of the items together
- Write thank you letters to George from the animals
- Make crowns like the one the animals gave to George
- Thinking about the goat in the story who needed a sail for his boat, see which household items float or sink
- Make a scarf for the giraffe out of paper chains
- Make a house for little toy figures in a grown up's shoe/boot like the mice in the story
- Count how many giant steps it takes to walk around a room/garden. Now count how many tiny steps it takes
- Stretch up and see how tall you can make yourself, now crouch down to see how small.
- See if you can tie your shoelaces or get dressed all by yourself
- Draw a map of where the George went around the town
- Arrange clothes/accessories in size order
